The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to the evening without prior notice. 5. We reserve the right to move your party to another carriage for logistical or other reasons beyond our control. 7. The set meal on the evening will be:-

**Starter:** Bocconcini Giardino salad. Pearls of bocconcini, sunblushed and vine tomato confit finished with balsamic reduction.

**Mains:** Pot roasted chicken supreme, forest mushroom, button onion and white bean ragout in a tarragon cream with roasted new potatoes. **Or** Basmati rice and vegetable biryani in a spiced tomato and cream sauce.

**Dessert:** Vanilla pannacotta with a Morello cherry compote.

Because of social distancing restrictions and limited space in the train kitchen this meal cannot be adjusted in any way.

**PLEASE NOTE** that the vegetarian/vegan mains: **MUST BE pre-ordered.**

You will find a map of how to find Sheffield Park Station on the bottom of your E-ticket. We advise that you leave plenty of time for your journey as you will be invited to witness the events leading up to the murder at 5.30pm. (*The bar will be open from 5pm, allowing you time to fortify those little grey cells!*). We will not be able to wait for guests running even a little late.

Once you have parked your car (*Having turned into the Bluebell Railway entrance, drive past the 1st car park and use the next one on the left, which is a little closer to the station building.*) please make your way to the **station ticket office** where you will be guided to where the murder will take place. **It is important that on arrival at Sheffield Park you enter the station via the ticket office allowing us to inform you as to how to locate your table in your dining carriage.**

We anticipate that the evening will finish around 10.25pm. **We strongly advise** that if you are using a taxi to arrive at Sheffield Park that you also arrange, **in advance**, your journey away at the end of the evening.

Because of technical complications the Bluebell are unable to take card payments for drinks purchased on the train – *paying by card for drinks brought at the bar before joining the train is not a problem.* At the start of the evening, if you are unable to bring cash with you, the Bluebell will offer a cash back service from the station bar, allowing you to pay cash on the train. **I'm afraid that the Bluebell Railway does not accept payments by cheque.**

If you require any further information relating to the evening please do not hesitate to contact us by one of the above methods

**For your safety: A message from the Bluebell Railway**

**Face Coverings** – must be worn in public places such as on the platforms and when boarding or alighting from the trains in accordance to Government guidance. Removal is acceptable in the bar, while witnessing the murder and when seated on-board the train.

**Table service** – All meals are hygienically plated. All our serving staff have been fully trained and will follow the government guidelines for serving of food and drinks. - 5.30 You will be invited to witness the events which lead up to and include the dastardly murder! *The murder is performed as a full theatrical event, with professional actors in full costume for the period of the production and using lighting, sound, set, props and special effect when needed.*
- 6.00 Join your steam pulled 1950's dining carriage where you will be presented with a detective pack full of information relating to the crime and clues relating to the six surviving suspects.
- 6.15 During your three-course plated meal you will be able to cross-examine the suspects, but remember that the murderer will deliberately lie to protect themselves and to keep a lookout for those tricky red herrings!  
Police/Pathology information will be issued as the evening progresses.  
The characters return for a second, but shorter cross-examination period.  
Over coffee and mints you will be invited to complete an answer form stating who did it, with what and the reasons why?
