



Bluebell Railway Vintage Transport Weekend Additional Information for Entrants.

The event has now become very popular on the rally calendar and we thank you for supporting us each year. As a result, we would ask that you take note of the following important and relevant information.

CAMPING ON SITE

- Camping on the rally site is very restricted and is only available to those entrants who request it on their entry form. This condition must be clearly understood. The organisers cannot accommodate ANY entrants who fail to request camping on the form and then turn up expecting to camp.
- Due to the terrain, the campsite is not flat. It is suitable in most areas for tents. Small caravans and trailer tents can be accommodated with care, but it's a 'choose your site carefully' situation, and on a first come first serve basis.
- The campsite is NOT suitable for medium/large motor homes (Winnebago or similar) they get bogged down in the soft ground and cannot manage the sloping terrain.
- If you intend to come along to the event in one of these camper vans, can we suggest staying at one of the Camping sites close to the event suitable for these types of vehicle. These sites may be found on local camping websites or from The Caravan Club and The Camping and Caravan Club. We are sorry that we have apply these conditions but we want everyone to enjoy the event to the full and if you know what to expect, then it should avoid any disappointments.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES.

If you would like to bring more than one vehicle to the event, EACH vehicle MUST be entered on SEPERATE entry forms. If you are downloading entry forms from the Bluebell Railway website, or it has been e.mailed to you, it is a simple operation to download as many as you need. If you obtain your entry form via the post, you can simply photocopy it for the number of vehicles you would like to bring along. The reason for this request is that it allows us to keep track of exactly how many vehicles we can expect - please remember that space on the rally field is at a premium. MULTIPLE ENTRIES RECEIVED ON ONE ENTRY FORM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. If you require clarification on entries, please phone on 01444 235801. or e.mail: stephen@peaks.demon.co.uk

We also ask that you put multiple vehicle entries in order of preference, 1, 2, 3 etc with No.1 as the highest preference, as we may have to restrict the number of entries per person. The event is becoming ever more popular, so it's only fair that as many as people as possible should get a chance to enter.

Which also means that should there be a change to your multiple entry i.e. a reduction in number OR type would you please let us know as soon as possible as this may allow another entrant to bring their vehicle along to the show.

NO SHOWS

We would draw your attention to the section on the entry form regarding non attendance. As the owners of a classic car ourselves, we are well aware that a problem can manifest itself at the last minute or even on the way to the show - be it to do with the vehicle or its owners! If you cannot make it to the show for whatever reason PLEASE LET US KNOW as soon as possible on 01444 235801 or on the day, 07941 071909.

We realise that some entrants book several shows for the same day and pick which event to attend on the day. The effect of this is that it stops another potential entrant coming to our show. We always have a waiting list and it is very frustrating to have unused spaces on the day, that we could have released to people on that waiting list.
