Entry is on a first come, first served basis. Your entry will be confirmed by post (in your SAE) within 28 days. If you have not received a reply within this time, then please contact the organisers at the contact details below. If you have provided an email address for contact, a reminder and any last-minute instructions will be sent to you a few days before the event.

On arrival, each entry will be supplied with passes admitting up to two adults & two children to the event, and the station area. The Bluebell Railway will also provide discount vouchers for two Adult Privilege rate 3rd Class rail travel tickets and up to two Child Privilege rate 3rd Class rail travel tickets for use on each of the event days

We would respectfully ask that if your entry has been confirmed and you are physically able to attend – subject to breakdowns/illness/emergencies of course, PLEASE do honour your entry.

Section 5 TERMS & CONDITIONS.

1. All motorcycles must be presented in a clean, complete and safe working order.
2. All motorcycles must be on site before 10:00 and must not depart before 16:30 on each day of the event without prior permission from the organisers. If you need to leave early, please advise the stewards when you book in on the day(s) of the event.
3. No vehicle movements on site between 10:00 and 16:30 without prior permission.
4. Please adhere to the site speed limit of 5mph.
5. No rider shall be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
6. No motorcycles will be permitted on site without evidence of current road fund license, adequate insurance, and MOT. Exceptions such as racing motorcycles may be possible with prior permission.
7. Motorcycles and riders may arrive on site from 08:00 Friday 20th August 2010.
8. Motorcycles and riders must be off site by 18:00 latest on Monday 23rd August 2010
9. Vehicles not officially entered to the event or not meeting the terms & conditions will only be admitted to the site at the discretion of the Section Organisers.
10. Entrants agree to comply with reasonable instructions from officials and stewards.
11. If you require overnight camping at Horsted Keynes, please indicate on this form. Written permission is required subject to conditions 7 & 8 above.
12. You must enclose a Stamped Self-Addressed Envelope (SAE) with your completed entry form.
